Get involved with CPOC's new Green Paper project

We are delighted to today launch a new nine-month policy development and research project aimed at producing the UK's first ever perioperative care green paper. Green papers are policy reports aimed at sparking discussion and shaping the future direction of travel for a specific issue of critical importance. We believe in the wake of the pandemic, that the time is right for CPOC to now advance our own priorities for immediate policy change to recover from COVID, alongside a united vision for the future transformation of the surgical pathway in the long-term.

For the next nine months, we will be carrying forward a varied programme of activity (including virtual parliamentary events, surveys, workshops, and focus groups) to better understand the current challenges and opportunities. The project will culminate in the publication of our Green Paper final report in the Autumn.
