Up to 14% of patients regret having undergone surgery, and previous Cochrane reviews suggests implementing shared decision making reduces the number of patients who choose major surgical interventions. Ensuring patients make informed choices has recently been the focus of new GMC and MICE guidance, and there are now a vast number of resources to help patients and clinicians arrive at decisions in partnership. FPM Survey on Postoperative Prescribing

The FPM will be carrying out a survey on postoperative prescribing.
